The portfolio includes single-use or single-patient-use kit configurations with cuffed and uncuffed tracheostomy tubes available with or without multiple fenestrations. Moreover, a large range of accessories is available both with sets and separately. The Rüsch[®] TracheoFix[™] Tracheostomy Tube sets are packaged in a handy pouch for bedside use to ensure they are easily accessible in a ward or home care environment, and to protect accessories and the replacement tube from airborne contaminants.

The Rüsch[®] TracheoFix[™] Tracheostomy Tubes have size-specific colour-coded inner cannulas (available with or without a 15 mm connector) that correspond to the matching coloured information on the flange. Moreover, the inner cannula can be removed and cleaned or replaced, helping to prevent the accumulation of biofilm and secretions, which could occlude the outer cannula and restrict ventilation. The flexibility of the flange enables it to conform to the anatomy and provides ease of access to the stoma site for cleaning and dressing changes, while the curved tube is designed to be easy to insert, supporting carers in the community setting.
